He was also selected to represent Puerto Rico in the Inter-American Sustainable Development Law Moot Court Competition, held in Río de Janeiro, Brazil, and later served as a student advisor to the team that competed the following year. In 2014, Mr. Palerm co-authored a proposal to create a research and manufacturing institute for sustainable renewable energy technology that was included by the Governor of Puerto Rico in the island's Economic Recovery Agenda.
