The U.S. District Court for the District of Puerto Rico issued an Order regarding the Virtual Courtroom System that will be implemented after April 15, 2020.

Following is a summary of the Order:

- The Order reaffirms the continuance of all civil and criminal proceedings until April 15, 2020
- After April 15, 2020, the Court will operate through a virtual courtroom system, having enabled a Video Tele-Conferencing ("VTC") system.
- Attorneys will receive advanced notification of their participation in VTC hearings or conferences and will be provided instructions on how to connect to the system.
- Criminal hearings that require the presence of defendants will be held using the VTC system available at MDC and the Bayamón State Penitentiary.
