### McV Litigation Alert

March 16, 2020

As many of you may know, yesterday Governor Wanda Vázquez issued **Executive Order 2020-023** to make feasible the necessary closings of Government offices and the private sector, so as to counter the effects of the Coronavirus (COVID-19) and control the risk of transmission in the Island.

As a result, both the Commonwealth and the federal courts have issued directives which we are summarizing below:

#### Matters before the Commonwealth's courts:

- in general, all hearings that had been scheduled between March 16 and March 30 are continued
- all terms that would have expired between March 16 and April 14, will now expire on April 15
- For more details, please refer to the **Supreme Court Resolution EM-2020-03**

#### Matters before the U.S. District Court for the District of Puerto Rico:

- all civil trials, hearings and conferences which were scheduled between March 16 and March 30 are continued, pending further order from the Court
- electronic filings will continue through CM/ECF

Changes to these directives can be expected, and we will be closely monitoring the respective courts' websites for further amendments or revisions.
