*“As for the Petraeus affair, Ford feels there’s a lesson there that PR pros should take to heart: ‘Work with HR and IT to dig up your old e-mail policies and get them up to date,’ she says. ‘And make sure employees—and leadership in particular—follow the rules.’”*
