Nici Workman, partner in the Vorys Columbus office, was selected as one of *Columbus Business First's* 2019 40 Under 40 Nominees. This year, the 40 honorees were selected from a pool of 378 nominees.

She chairs the Vorys Women's Network, serves on two firm committees (the Diversity & Inclusion and Management Committees), helps plan citywide legal industry gender equity programming, serves on the board of Ruling our Experiences (ROX), is the President-Elect of Capital University's Alumni Advisory Board, and has served as a mentor to female lawyers, in their first year of practice, for the past six years.
