Update Highlights

- The European Patent Office (EPO) is postponing all EPO live events until September 14, 2020. The 2020 edition of the European Inventor Award, planned to be held in Monaco on June 17-18, has also been postponed to June 17, 2021.
- The Intellectual Property Office of the United Kingdom (UKIPO) is currently unable to issue any letters in relation to patent renewals, recommending to proactively manage renewals rather than relying on these letters. These letters will be issued once the office re-opens.
- Other general closures & deadline extensions have been added to the document.
