### Update Highlights

- The Federal Circuit has updated its access restrictions to the National Courts Building complex through August 31, 2021. All persons must wear a mask, regardless of vaccination status. Fully vaccinated individuals, though, do not need to observe social distancing.
- The USPTO has made the **July 2021 Trademark Manual of Examining Procedure** (TMEP) available online. The update reflects final rules, examination guides, and any other statement of USPTO policy, as well Supreme Court decisions. The USPTO also published a **change summary**.
- The European Patent Office (EPO) has announced that the Boards of Appeal have revised some of their measures for the arrangement and conduct of oral proceedings: self tests are strongly recommended and new rules on access to the buildings for vaccinated and recovered people are in place.
